Graduate Class of 2018

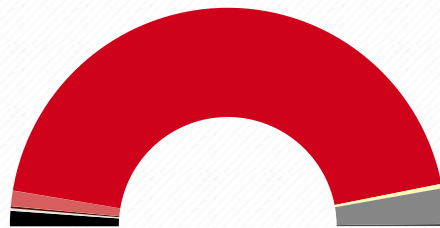
Executive Summary:

Data from eighty-three percent (83.38%) of the 2018 graduate degree recipients was collected from online surveys, faculty, employers, and other verifiable information sources in accordance with the National Association of Colleges and Employers' First Destination Standards. (89.9% knowledge rate based upon data obtained for 306 out of 367 total graduates.)

94% of the respondents from the graduate **Class of 2018** survey (May, August, December graduates) reported success in achieving their post-graduate goals. 5.2% were still seeking full-time employment.

Class of 2018 Residency:

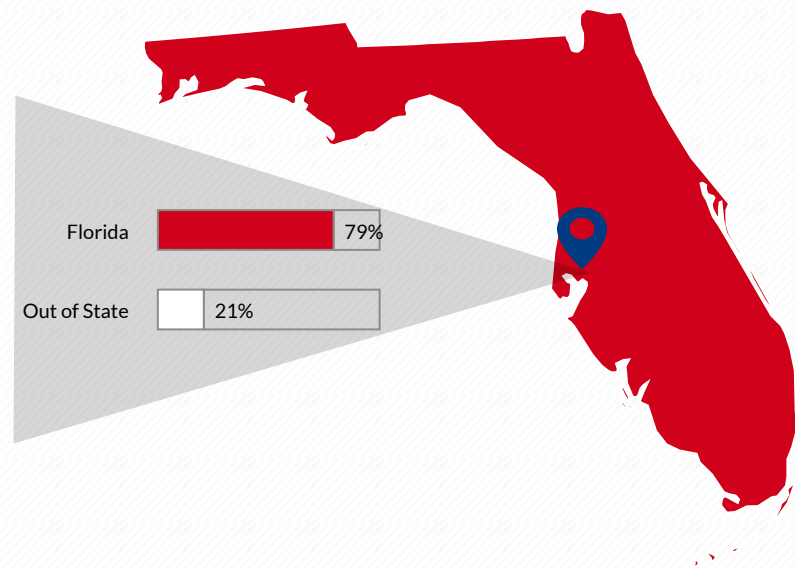
Graduates from the Class of 2018 live all across the US and internationally.

278 of the 367 graduates responding to our survey reported where they planned to live after graduation.

Seventy-nine percent (79%) of the Class of 2018 graduates responding to our survey report Florida as their top destination after graduation - choosing to remain in Florida for either graduate school or employment opportunities.

Internationally, UT graduates are employed or attend graduate school in Europe, Africa, Asia, the Caribbean, the Middle East, Central and South America, Australia and Canada.

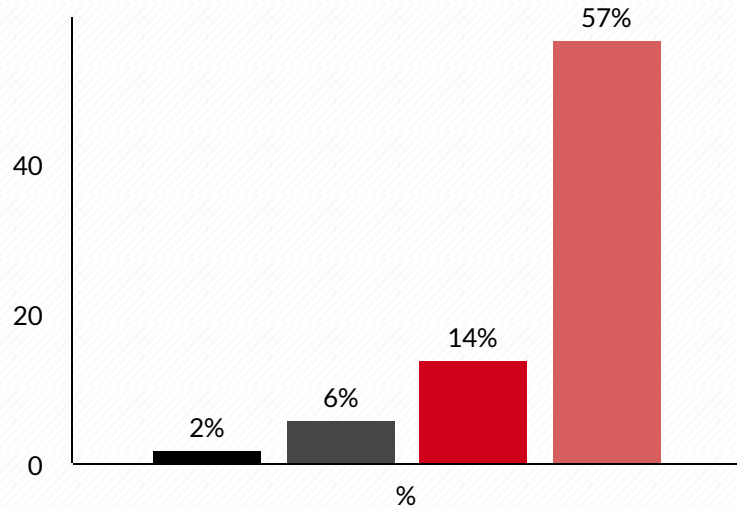

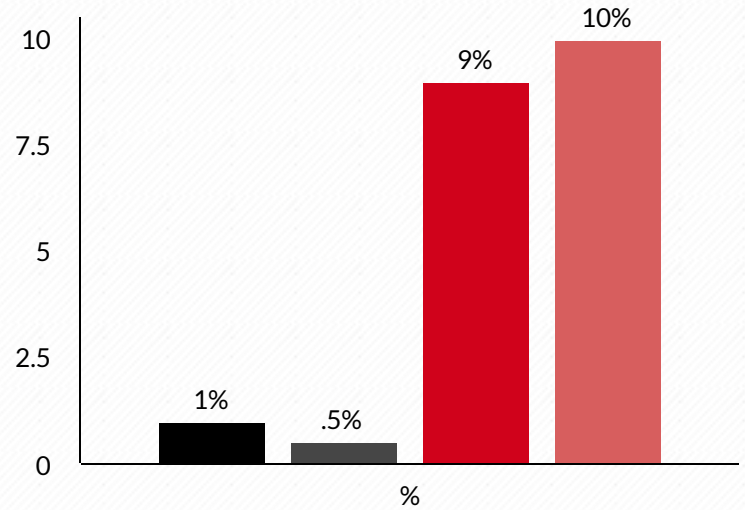

Class of 2018 Employers:

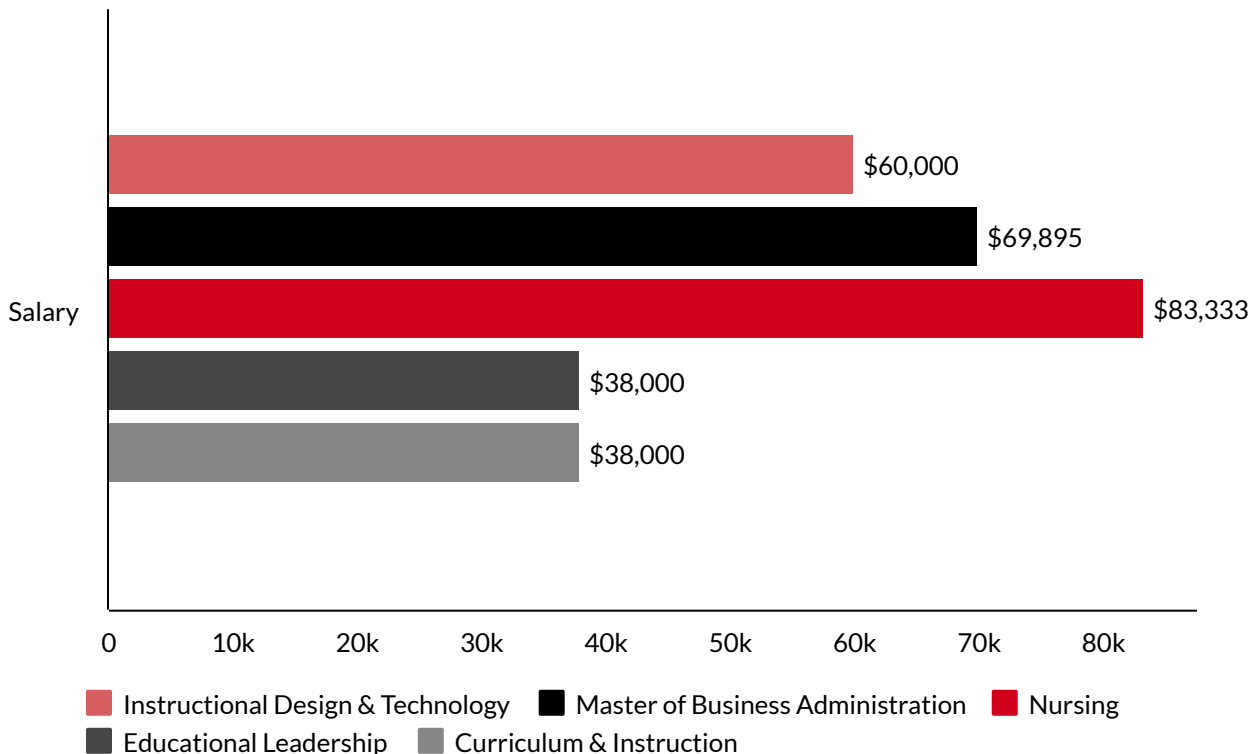
The career paths of the respondents are varied and span most industries. Below is a sample list of employers:



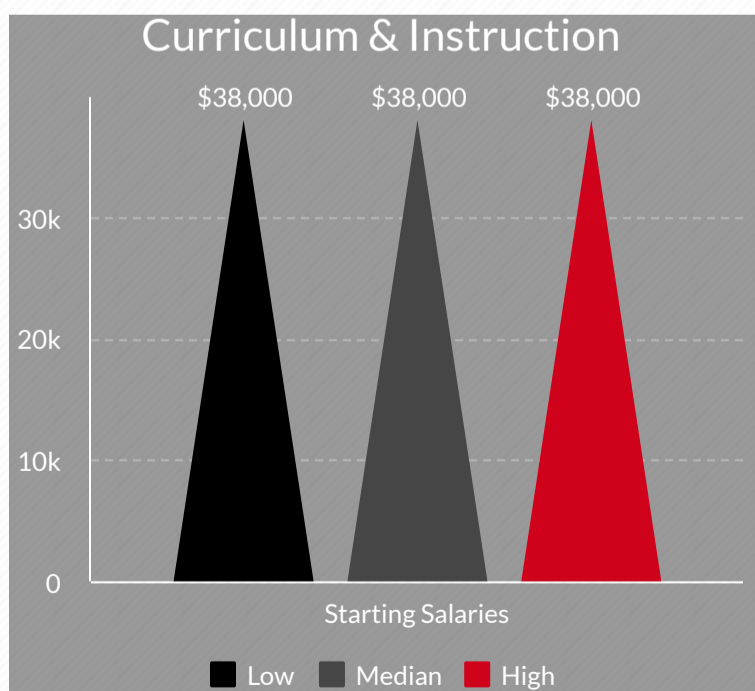
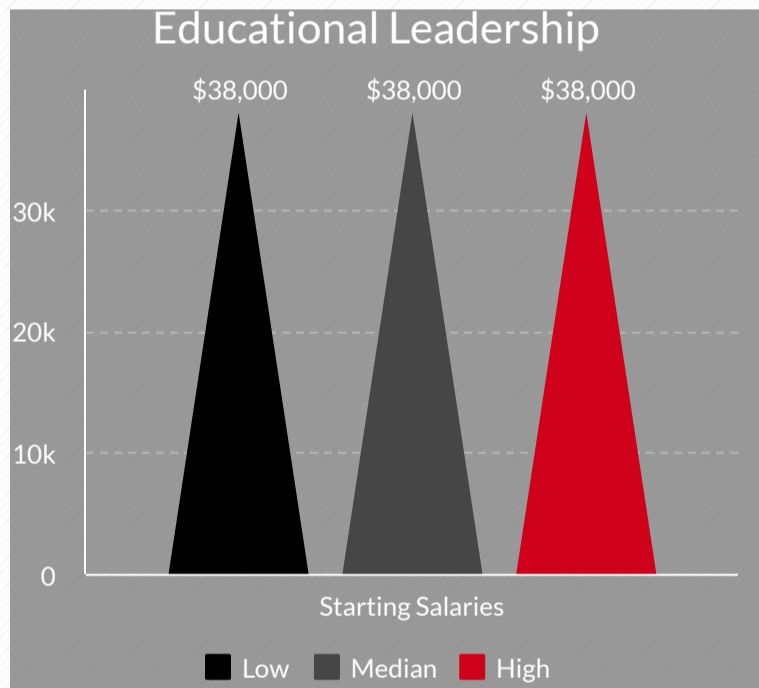
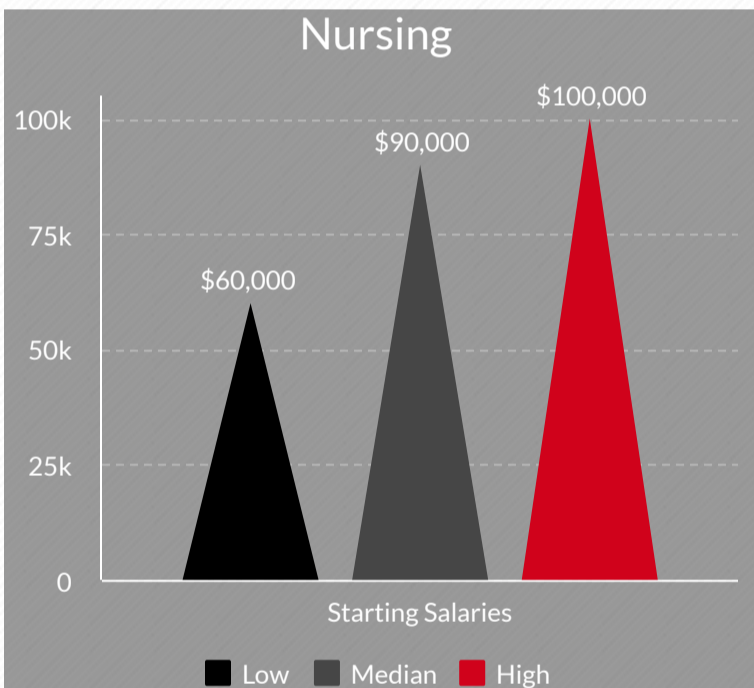
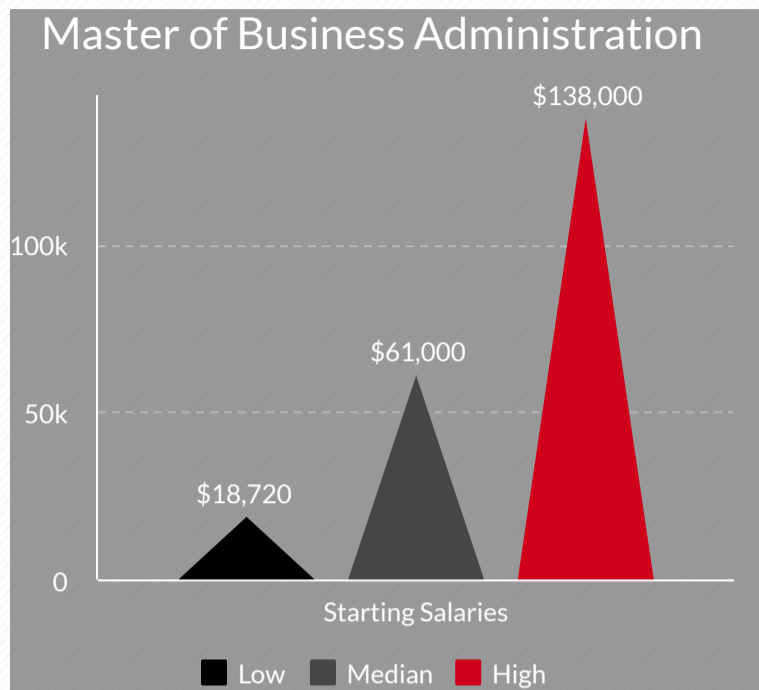
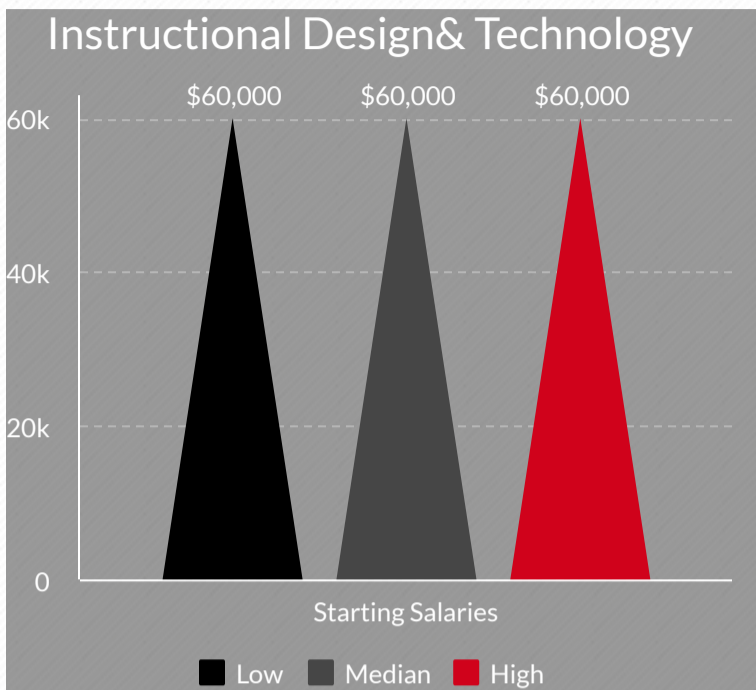
Salary Data Reported:

Respondents are not required to provide salary data. The salary statistics below are based upon 31 respondents who chose to disclose their annual salary for full-time employment. Salary information reflects self-reported base salary and does not include commissions, bonuses or other variable sources of income.

For purposes of calculating the mean, median, maximum and minimum salary information, the midpoint of the reported salary range is utilized for each respondent.



Office of Career Services: Services and Resources Utilized

Of the graduates who responded to the survey, 40 specified that they had utilized the Office of Career Services. Of those 40 respondents:

- 10% reported attending graduate school
- 50% reported they were employed full time
- 5% reported working part time
- 32.5% reported still seeking employment
- 2.5% reported waiting for acceptance to graduate school.
