The events of 2020 and now 2021 have proven a simple fact; we are all the better because of research

discoveries and creative insights. From the wildfires in Australia and California, to the locust swarms that devested corps in Africa and the Arabian Peninsula, the COVID-19 pandemic, historic jobless rates, the episodes of systemic racism that polarized our collective consciousness, and the disruptions to our democratic processes, the past 14 months presented unimaginable challenges that demanded solutions that only research could address. As a scholar, what can you do to help your family, friends, and community understand the challenges affecting societies as well as the latest discoveries and insights that work to correct the problems?

This workshop will help you learn how to share the results of your work effectively and clearly. In doing so, you will learn some tips to make the evidence both understandable and valued. Even if we overcome everything in 2020, we will always need scholars to help solve societal issues as well as better understand life, the universe, and everything. As a researcher, you, therefore, have a responsibility to share those beautiful insights with both the academic and general communities.
