

## Meeting Baccalaureate Experience Requirements with Approved Spartan Studies Courses

This document provides information about how courses approved for Spartan Studies may also be used to meet baccalaureate experience requirements for students who started prior to Fall 2023. Courses that meet baccalaureate experience requirements in the 2022 – 2023 catalog will continue to meet baccalaureate experience requirements as long as they are offered ***unless otherwise noted in the current catalog***. Courses that meet baccalaureate experience requirements ***do not*** automatically meet any Spartan Studies requirements.

Course approved for Natural Science distribution	6 credits natural science <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 biological</li> <li>• 3 chemical/physical</li> </ul> Notes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• if a student has not successfully completed any natural science courses prior to Fall 2023 – they will need one 4-credit course/course sequence as approved for Spartan Studies, any discipline</li> <li>• if a student has successfully completed one 3-credit course, they will need to complete an additional natural science course that is a minimum of 3 credits either at UT or somewhere else, ideally in the discipline not yet completed</li> </ul>
